Stage 01

3 WEEKS BEFORE

Initiation

- Seeking Information from Base Builder to provide any protocols or process. required to follow before commencing the works
- Seeking information from Vendors for Labour Counts
- Informing Client and Base builder about labours count along with Precautionary measures
- Seeking confirmation from base builder for readiness of the entire campus for entry and to start the works at site



Stage 02

2 WEEKS BEFORE

Procurement

- Cost from vendors for one time labour medical check up and costing for PPE's
- Providing the cost to client for approval
- Deliver all PPE's to site
- Disposable face masks - 3 ply (standard)/face masks (N-95)
- Hand gloves - reusable/use & throw
- Sanitizer bottle -500ML
- Infrared thermal temp machines
- Shoe wrapping machines(which wraps shoes with plastic, use and throw)
- Separate dust bins (for keeping the used gloves and masks)
- Safety goggles and full bodysuits for housekeeping staff
- Sanitizer spray machine (manual/battery)
- Non spray - manual cleaning agents /disinfection of critical equipments & areas
- Consumables - sanitization of site services



Stage 03

1 WEEK BEFORE

Onsite Implementation

- Sensitization of entire site and material.
- Training to all vendors EHS representatives for implementing the processes at site
- Briefing to all labours for following the processes at site and PPE's awareness
- Carrying out **Microbial Aerial Disinfection**
- Carrying out flushout
- Start up of systems one by one (testing & commissioning of MEP systems)

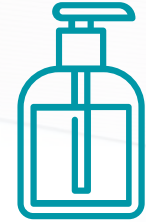

Talk to your landlords on premises readiness

- Fumigation of common areas before normal operations
- Sanitization of high touch surfaces
- Training of the housekeeping and security to deal with post COVID operations
- Lift operations to be touchfree

03

Pre-activities/ Preventive Maintenance

- Disinfection of complete area and surface of the site
- Disinfection of all materials at site
- Availability of all sanitizing materials & equipments at site
- 24/7 security office availability at site
- Check all PPE's available at site
- Display of all safety posters

Microbial Aerial Disinfection (MAD)

- Carry out a holistic microbial disinfection treatment
- Reference for MAD procedure

05

Flushout & Start Up of Systems

- Plan for the flushout to have ample buffer between the treatment and move-in
- Start up systems procedure

06

Follow Process

- Training to labours and informing processes to be followed
- Home quarantine of the labour for 7-14 days as guideline issued by MOHFW
- Thermal screening at site for each employee every 4 hours with records maintained for each day
- ID card must for each employee and labour
- Visitor Management
